

## LISTING OF SUPPLIES REQUIRED FOR PRE-K-GRADE 1

**\*\*During the first week of School parents are asked to bring/send supply money into school in an envelope marked with the child's name, homeroom and "Money for Supplies"**

**\*\*\* All students are asked to furnish 3 rolls of paper towels, 3 boxes of tissues, 1 Lysol Wipes, 1 large bottle hand sanitizer, and 1 package of napkins for their homeroom\*\*\*  
(please bring these supplies the first week of school)**

### ***PRE-K-3:***

Students will receive their supplies from the teachers. During the first week of school parents are asked to bring/send \$42.00 in an envelope marked with the child's name and "Money for Supplies". All items are included in the supply fee. Pre-K-3 students will receive:
